In his role as Chief Innovation Officer, Toni Miranda will manage AWAAIT's H2020 SME Instrument Phase 2 grant, awarded earlier in 2017, with two main objectives: scale up and internationalize the company's DETECTOR system and expand AWAAIT's current positive innovation gap.

Toni holds a MS in Technology Commercialization from the McCombs School of Business at The University of Texas at Austin and a BS and a MS in Telecom Engineering from Polytechnic University of Catalonia and La Salle Engineering School, respectively.
